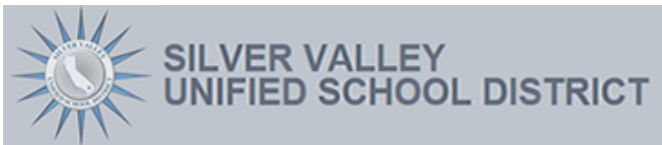

Individuals wishing to address the Board may do so by joining the SVUSD Regular Meeting Webinar. Please complete the registration form and answer all questions prior to the beginning of the meeting. Individual speakers, after being recognized, shall be allowed three minutes to address the Board on each agenda or non-agenda item. The Board shall limit the total time for public input to 20 minutes. With Board consent, the Board President may increase or decrease the time allowed for public presentation, depending on the topic and the number of persons wishing to be heard. The President may take a poll of speakers for or against a particular issue and may ask that additional persons speak only if they have something more to add. At the conclusion of the Public Comment section, the Board will only take comments from the public on each individual item at the discretion of the Board President. The Board President is in charge of the meeting and will maintain order and will have the prerogative to remove any person who is disruptive of the Board meeting.

Board meetings are for the purpose of conducting Board of Trustee business. Comments from the staff and public are for information to the Board members, therefore, there will be no debate with the public, nor debate between the public and staff, nor between individuals in the public. However, the Board, or individual Board members can solicit information from either the public or staff.
